

**Resolution No 54/2021
of the Management Board of Narodowy Bank Polski
of 3 December 2021**

amending the resolution on the terms and conditions of sale by Narodowy Bank Polski of coins, banknotes, and numismatic items for collection and other purposes

Under Article 36 of the Act of 29 August 1997 on Narodowy Bank Polski (Dziennik Ustaw / Dz. U. [Journal of Laws] of 2020, item 2027 and of 2021, item 1598), it is hereby resolved as follows:

§ 1. Annex 1 to Resolution No 43/2013 of the Management Board of Narodowy Bank Polski of 5 December 2013 on the terms and conditions of sale by Narodowy Bank Polski of coins, banknotes, and numismatic items for collection and other purposes (M.P. [Official Gazette] of 2021, item 1067) shall be amended as follows:

1) in § 2:

a) after item 6), item 6a) shall be added, reading as follows:

“6a) payment instrument – payment instrument within the meaning of Article 2(10) of the Act of 19 August 2011 on Payment Services (Journal of Laws of 2021, items 1907, 1814 and 2140), enabling individual and institutional recipients to make payments: at the NBP Regional Branch in Warsaw, with a payment card or contactless BLIK, in the online shop – with a payment card, by transfer, instant transfer or with BLIK;”,

b) item 7 shall read as follows:

“7) payment card – payment card within the meaning of Article 2(15a) of the Act of 19 August 2011 on Payment Services;”,

c) item 16 shall be repealed,

d) item 17 shall read as follows:

“17) payment in an NBP regional branch – payment made in cash or payment made with a payment card or contactless BLIK;”;

2) in § 5:

a) items 3-5 shall read as follows:

“3. The customer order placed by completing and accepting the order form represents an offer to purchase the product within the meaning of the provisions of the Polish Civil Code. While placing the order, the customer selects the method of payment and collection (courier delivery/collection at the NBP Regional Branch in Warsaw). In the event that the customer chooses the option of collecting the purchased items at the NBP Regional Branch in Warsaw, the notification of the

collection day shall be communicated no later than within 10 days of the date of submission of the order or the date of crediting the NBP account with the amount due. The customer may check the status of the order upon logging in to the account.

4. The order is approved for execution upon placing the order by the customer. The confirmation is sent automatically within 24 hours. It contains information on the order number and amount, method of payment and the collection of the ordered items. The details are also available upon logging in to the account.

5. While selecting the delivery of collector items by courier service, the customer undertakes to pay the full amount due for the order, including shipment costs, using the payment instrument, within 7 days of placing the order. The payment shall be deemed completed on the day of crediting the NBP account with the amount due for the items ordered.”,

b) item 11 shall read as follows:

“11. If no payment for the ordered collector items is received within 7 days of the placement of the order, the order will be cancelled. If the collector items are not collected at the NBP Regional Branch in Warsaw within 7 operating days from the items availability confirmation date, the order will be cancelled, the amount paid by the customer will be remitted to the account from which the payment originated or to the card used for making payment; the payment will be refunded within 14 days as of the scheduled collection day.”;

3) in § 8:

a) in para. 3 item 1 b shall read as follows:

“b) to the account of the payment card from which the payment originated;”,

b) in para. 4 item 1 b shall read as follows:

“b) to the account of the payment card from which the payment originated, or”.

§ 2. The Resolution shall enter into force on 27 December 2021.
